Year 6 Performance Tickets Re:

We are really excited to be having a Year 6 production again this year. All of the children will have the opportunity to be involved in the performance of Bugsy Malone whether they are actors, in the lights and music team, stage hands, in the IT team or in the props team.

There will be two performances for parents:

- Matinee performance for parents Monday 8th July 1pm
- Evening performance for parents Tuesday 9th July 6:30pm

The matinee performance on Monday 8th July will start at 1pm, doors will be open from 12:45pm. PAWHS will be selling refreshments before the show commences. We are expecting act 1 and 2 to be around 45 minutes each and there will be a half way interval for the actors and actresses to change over and the PAWHS will be selling refreshments during this time. We expect the performance to end at around 2:45pm.

The evening performance on Tuesday 9th July will start at 6:30pm, doors will be open from 6pm. PAWHS will be selling refreshments before the show commences. We are expecting act 1 and 2 to be around 45 minutes each and there will be a half way interval for the actors and actresses to change over and the PAWHS will be selling refreshments during this time. We expect the performance to end and children to be ready to be dismissed at around 8:30pm.

Please be aware that both the matinee and evening performances for families will be limited to 120 tickets due to health and safety and fire regulations for the hall. This will mean that they will be restricted to a maximum of 2 tickets per family – this includes any children watching the show so we cannot have 2 adults and a child coming to see the performance. Also, to allow as many of our parents to watch the shows, you will only be able to watch either the matinee or evening performance. We will show the performance to the children in school time.
